Golf Membership Waitlist Policy Recommendation

"Our mission is to provide an exceptional private club experience and support a healthy lifestyle in an environment that fosters fun, camaraderie, and community."

If at any time the total number of Regular Golf Memberships and Young Executive Memberships, collectively is 368 or greater, then a waitlist shall be in effect pursuant to Article II, Section 2.2 of the Club's Restated Bylaws. The rules shall be as follows:

1. To be placed on the waitlist, an applicant shall complete the required golf membership application process and pay a non-refundable \$5,000 option fee.
2. If at any time an applicant desires to be removed from the waitlist, his or her name shall be removed, and no option fee shall be refunded or applied toward a future initiation fee.
 - a. If the applicant wishes to remain an athletic member, the current initiation fee will be waived.
3. When a golf membership becomes available, the Club will contact the applicant at the top of the waitlist via phone and/or email. The offer must be accepted within 72 hours or the applicant will be removed from the waitlist.
4. If an opening occurs but the applicant still desires to remain on the waitlist, a second non-refundable fee of \$5,000 shall be submitted to the Club, and the applicant shall be placed at the bottom of the list.
5. All option fees collected by the Club while on the waitlist shall be credited towards the current initiation fee in effect at the time of the offer and acceptance of a full golf membership.
6. When the applicant is approved, he or she will become a Waitlist - Golf Family, Waitlist - Golf Individual or Waitlist - Golf Young Executive member paying the current Athletic Family, Pair or Individual Membership Dues and Capital Dues and having the same access to the Club as current athletic members.
 - a. There is no minimum commitment for this Waitlist - Athletic membership if the applicant chooses to remove his or her name from the waitlist.
 - b. The applicant will have the same privileges as a current athletic member.
7. If the applicants on the waitlist are legally separated or divorced, the primary member has the legal right to that option fee.
 - a. If the primary does not wish to pursue membership, the spouse would have the option to take his or her place on the waiting list pending Board approval.
8. Upon the death of the applicant while on the waiting list, the spouse retains the right to pursue membership pending Board approval.
 - a. In the event of an individual membership the applicant is removed from the waiting list.
